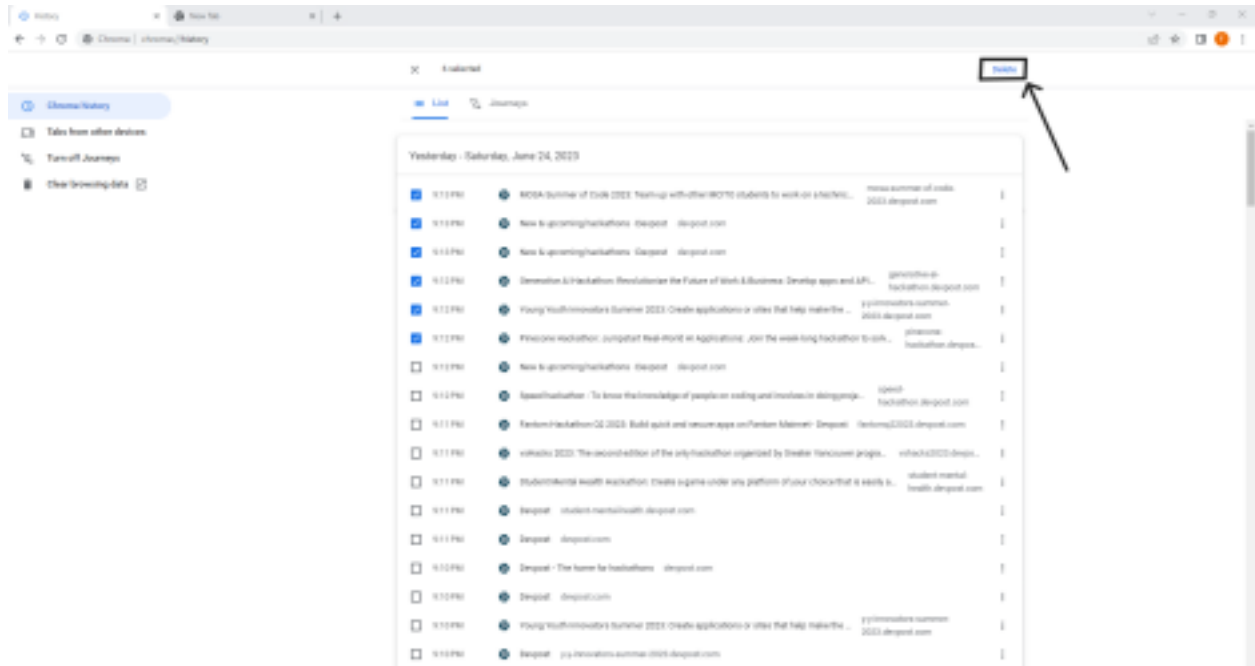


Google - Restore Button - History Section

Pictured is the generic chrome history section. The common delete button appears in the top right corner whenever multiple tabs are selected. It lets the user delete multiple unnecessary tabs within the history section with a single click.



Despite the incredible usefulness of the delete tab button, another feature can also be added and become incredibly useful to the Chrome engine user: the restore tabs button. Labeled as "Restore".

The "Restore" button should be placed next to the "Delete" button, ideally on its left side. Both buttons should have the same size (width and height). The "Restore" button allows users to reopen multiple tabs at once. Users can select the checkboxes for each tab they want to restore and click "Restore," which will automatically reopen all selected tabs. This feature is especially helpful when users want to reopen several tabs without having to open them one by one from the history page.
